**St. Vincent de Paul – Voice of the Poor...** Your help is needed to support the farm workers following the devastating freeze we recently experienced. While we are aware of the plight of the growers who lost the majority of their citrus crops, the growers can apply for relief under emergency declarations and many have insurance to cover some of their losses. There is little or no aid for the farm workers who pick the crops. Please help fight for these farm workers who will lose their jobs due to the freeze. Contact Senator Feinstein and ask Sen. Feinstein to work to get the federal government to declare a national emergency as she did after the 98-99 freeze. Ask her to make sure emergency assistance provides unemployment insurance; rent or mortgage assistance; utilities assistance; and organized food distribution to farm workers and their stricken families. Your call is urgent - the farm workers and their families are dependent upon it. You can call

## COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

Two weeks ago at the nine o'clock mass we welcomed into our midst Robert Bell, through the Rite of Welcoming.
