Music and Liturgy

The Psalm is our next song in the Mass. It is an "integral part" of the Liturgy of the Word because it allows us to meditate on the Word of God. The Psalm should be sung whenever possible and it should always be a Psalm and not a song. In other words it should contain the words of the psalm and not be "taken from" the psalm as some of our hymns are. Here at St. Charles we most often sing the psalm that is chosen for the readings of the day and the arrangement that is in our Breaking Bread. We sometimes use what is called a seasonal psalm (the 5:00 Sunday group is doing that), and repeat it several times during a season. These texts have been chosen for us and we are free to use them instead of the specific psalm of the day. You also might notice that the Cantor goes to the ambo to sing the psalm. That is because it is part of the Liturgy of the Word, and it is sung from the place where the readings are proclaimed. It is also called "responsorial" because we do repeat the antiphon after the cantor and throughout the psalm. Comments? Feedback?
