**Women's Catholic Scripture Study
starts again Sept 11, 2008**

Women from parishes all around the Bay Area meet Thursdays from 10 am to noon at St. Mark's Parish in Belmont (ending in late May with holiday breaks for Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter). We'll be doing an overview of Scripture using the book, *Understanding the Scriptures: A Complete Course in Bible Study* by Dr. Scott Hahn. This will be the perfect study for those new to Bible study as well as those who would like a deeper understanding of the "overall picture" of salvation history. This book is being used in Catholic high schools, seminaries, and parish Bible study groups. A high school teacher from Denver commented, "I have taught for twenty-two years in a variety of subject areas and have never had such an excellent textbook. This is Dr. Hahn's covenant-based perspective on salvation history with copious quotes from Scripture, the Catechism, and various Church documents. The layout is beautiful and the text is interspersed with some of the most beautiful religious art ever created." Registration fee is \$10. and there is an additional fee for the book and workbook. We'll also be studying select Scripture passages, so you'll need your Bible, too. The study involves home study questions, small group discussions, and a live wrap-up lecture. Do you have an extra room to rent out? HIP Housing, a non-profit organization with 36 years of housing experience, is reaching out to the community to promote its **home sharing program**. In tough economic times with rising housing, utility, gas and other expenses, **home sharing** helps to reduce costs and enables persons to save money. Two types of arrangements are facilitated: straight rent exchange and service exchange which involves helping with cooking, cleaning, companionship and other basic services in lieu of or for reduced rent. All clients are interviewed by our experienced staff and clients are able to interview each other and make their own decision about selecting housemates. Resources on how to interview clients, Living Together Agreements, follow-up support and mediation are also available through this service. And, the home sharing program is free to San Mateo County residents! There are over 170 persons seeking housing through our program. Let us help you find a housemate to put that empty room to good use!

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading - You shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all others (*Exodus 19:2-6a*).

Psalm - We are his people: the sheep of his flock (*Psalm 100*).

Second Reading - We boast of God through Christ Jesus, through whom we have been reconciled (*Romans 5:6-11*).

Gospel - Jesus commissioned the Twelve: Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons (*Matthew 9:3 - 10:8*).

LABOR SHORTAGE

Jesus explained two thousand years ago what we know to be true—that “the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few” (Matthew 9:37). We are always searching for more laborers for the harvest of the Master. Among all the baptized, priests and others who have chosen a religious life have given over their entire lives to be laborers in God’s vineyard. They have answered God’s call in a unique way to work the harvest and to proclaim by word and action—like Peter, Andrew, and the rest of the Twelve—that the kingdom of heaven is indeed at hand. We know that God will not leave us as “sheep without a shepherd” (Matthew 9:36), and so we trust that our prayers and efforts will yield the shepherds that God desires for us.
