

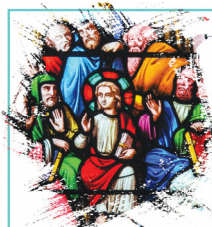

Help Our Parish Children Engage During the 8:30 Mass

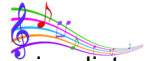
