Four times a year, during months with five Sundays, our parish has a second collection at all Masses to support the **St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Conference**. We depend on your donations to be able to provide for families in need. All funds collected are used to support the needs of our neighbors.

Our Conference makes an average of 30 home visits each month providing needed groceries, dairy products and fresh produce to our neighbors. In addition to the groceries, Safeway cards for household needs and Target cards for diapers are also provided. Other resources regularly available for our neighbors include transit cards and adult and children's clothing vouchers.

This month the St. Charles Conference also conducted a clothing drive. Items collected will be available for infants, children, teens and adults at our St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Shop in San Mateo. Items may also be a resource for the San Mateo Homeless Help Center.

At times, the St. Vincent de Paul Conference can be a resource for special circumstances. We work to alleviate such issues as the need for appliances (and/or appliance repair); requests for furniture; and, financial assistance for emergency situations.

At the Masses for September 28th and 29th, the second collection will be to support our efforts to help our San Carlos neighbors. Donations can also be made by depositing cash or checks into the SVdP boxes located on the wall at the church entrances, or by donating online on the Parish website under Parish Groups, St. Vincent De Paul Society.

Help Our Neighbors and Donate Usable Clothing!

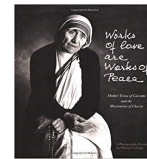
