Frances Xavier Cabrini was the first United States citizen to be canonized and is the patron saint of immigrants. She herself was an immigrant to the U.S., having traveled from Italy to New York City in 1889 to work with the thousands of Italian immigrants living there. They were struggling to find welcome or opportunity in the New World at the time and were losing faith. In 35 years, despite many obstacles, St. Frances founded 67 institutions dedicated to caring for the poor, the abandoned, the uneducated and the sick. Frances Cabrini's feast day is celebrated on November 13.
